Free flying will be possible on Monday till Wednesday

Opening Ceremony will take place on Thursday, 24. July 2025 at 9 a.m.

World Championship Light Class:

Thursday 24. July 9 a.m. till Sunday 27. July 2 p.m.

Price giving ceremony will take place on Sunday the 27. July in the afternoon.

The competition flights will take place from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Latest Arrival: Thursday 24. July 2025.

There is no free flying possible on this day.

Regulations:

All regulations will be uploaded soon on <https://gps-triangle.net/> [GPS Triangle](#) .

The valid rule-set for Light Class will be Version V2.1.

Flight schedule: Flying is possible outside official flight schedules after permission of airfield flight control. Safety zones, pedestrians and vehicle traffic must be always observed and respected.

All competitors must have valid insurance.

Evaluation:

Successions:

At least 6 rounds are scheduled (2-3 per day).

Food & Drinks:

Drinks, coffee and snacks are available on the airfield at all times.

Lunch is served at the airfield. Dinner is served in the community center (2 km away, 3 min by car, probably shuttleservice)

Accommodation:**Camping:**

Camping is possible next to the airfield (10 €/day, payable at the airfield).

Bread roll service available.

You must provide your own power supply.

Toilets are on site, but no washing facilities.

Washing and shower facilities are available at the community center (2 km, 3 min by car, shuttleservice).

Selection of Pilots:

The number of entries will be limited to 48 competitors.

We will fly in 4 groups of maximum 12 pilots (groups will be adjusted if there are less pilots).

All pilots who wish to enter shall do so using the entry form on www.rcmodelsport.com

www.rcmodelsport.com until 31. May 2025.

Registration deadline is the 31. Mai 2024 and the entered selected pilots as well as a "waiting list" (if applicable) will be published shortly after.

Necessary documents and model marking:

- Insurance
- EASA Identification number (eID-number) visibly marked on the model airplanes.
- Proof of knowledge ("Kenntnisnachweis") or training certificate ("Schulungsnachweis") will be checked before opening.

These documents are mandatory, flying without these documents will NOT BE POSSIBLE!

It's allowed to use 2 models at the competition. Models will be marked with small stickers (stickers are available at the field).

MfC Heudorf is a member of the Deutscher Modellflieger Verband e.V. (DMFV e.V.). Depending on the country of origin and whether the pilot is a member of a national model flying association or not, there are different requirements. These are listed clearly in the following table:

You will not need an additional A1/A3 certificate from the Luftfahrtbundesamt as this will be covered by the DMFV proof of knowledge. You only need the eID from Luftfahrtbundesamt if you not have one from your national aviation office yet. eID is valid within the european union.

EASA Identification number (eID)

From May 1, 2021, all unmanned aircraft (including model aircraft) within the European Union must be marked with the personal registration number (e-ID). The legislator has not imposed any special requirements on the method of marking. A QR code is permissible. The number can also be placed inside the model. eID of other countries within the European Union are recognized.

Proof of knowledge ("Kenntnisnachweis") / training certificate ("Schulungsnachweis"):

In Germany, a proof of knowledge ("Kenntnisnachweis") / training certificate ("Schulungsnachweis") is mandatory required to operate a model aircraft at altitudes of more than 120 meters above ground or with a take-off weight of more than 2 kilograms. This applies to flying on and off model airfields. This proof of knowledge / training certificate certifies that the owner has knowledge of the basics of the use and navigation of model aircraft, the relevant legal principles and the local airspace regulations.
